CLEXANE® Abbreviated Prescribing Information

1. NAME AND PRESENTATION: Clexane® is available as pre-filled syringes containing 20 mg, 40 mg, 60 mg, 80 mg enoxaparin sodium for injection.

2. THERAPEUTIC INDICATIONS: Prophylaxis of thromboembolic diseases of venous origin (VTE) in particular those which occur as a complication of general surgery. CONTRAINDICATIONS: Acute bacterial endocarditis, severe bleeding disorders, thrombocytopenia with a positive in vitro aggregation test in the presence of enoxaparin, active gastric or duodenal ulceration, hypersensitivity to enoxaparin, severe renal or hepatic insufficiency, increased risk of hemorrhage when treated with enoxaparin, concurrent treatment with antiplatelet drugs, concurrent treatment with thrombolytic agents.

5. SPECIAL WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS FOR USE: Enoxaparin sodium should not be substituted. Regular patient blood monitoring should be considered prior to and during therapy. Should be used with caution when required hemostasis. History of peptic ulcer, recent lumbar puncture, concurrent systemic antifungal treatment, reduced renal or hepatic function, surgery, especially of genitourinary system, hemorrhage and should be treated as usual. 8. UNDESIRABLE EFFECTS: Bleeding may occur in the presence of associated risk factors such as, amongst others, falls or head or spinal injury.
